

**5-day Quilt workshop with Nancy Crow:  
IMPROVISATIONAL EXERCISES: PART 1  
March 9 - 13th, 2024  
at the Textilmuseum Neumünster, Germany**

**WORKSHOP OPPORTUNITY:** Before the March 15th, 2024, **Grand Opening** of the new exhibition **COLOR IMPROVISATIONS 3** curated by **Nancy Crow**, Nancy will give a 5-day workshop to a select group of 15 - 20 participants.

This workshop is directed at people who are experienced at free-hand cutting, know their way around a sewing machine, and want to work spontaneously and intuitively with nontraditional quilt-making techniques as they explore design exercises that promote improvisational approaches to composition without benefit of 'pre-planning' and 'intellectualizing'.

**IMPROVISATIONAL EXERCISES: PART I:** This brand new 5-day class has been specifically developed for students desirous of being far more experimental using machine-piecing techniques. This is not a beginning class but is intended for serious intermediate to advanced artist whose preferred medium is quilt making.

This is a **unique opportunity** to participate in a Nancy Crow workshop without having to travel to the USA.

- The class will be translated into German.
- If you have studied with Nancy in Germany or Switzerland in the past, this is a new workshop with new exercises, which she has never presented in Europe before.

**Class level:** intermediate / advanced

**Dates:** 9 - 13th March, 2024, 5-day workshop

**Place:** Textilmuseum Neumünster

**Tuition:** 1.300€ per participant

**Accommodation:** not included (we will offer a package with half-pension at a nearby hotel soon)

**Registration:** the registration form will soon be available on the Textilmuseum website - the registration will become valid when the down payment has been received
